

COURSE DESCRIPTION: (Taken from college catalog)

In this course students explore the world of computing as it relates to various areas of ministry and church administration. Topics covered include desktop publishing, use of the Internet, database management, computer networks, on-line services, information resources, and contact management.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

<u>Homework</u>: Overall, homework is a very important part of this course. Homework assignments are due at the <u>beginning</u> of the next class period after they are assigned. Class does not begin when you arrive. If you are late, your assignment is late.

PLEASE NOTE: I give 50% credit for late homework. After two weeks I do not accept late work. No late work is accepted after the last week of class (other than the <u>class journal</u> and the <u>take home final</u>). It is *your* responsibility to keep up with or obtain information (handouts, etc.) from the professor or classmates in the event of *your* absence.

Attendance: Students need to attend class regularly to achieve an acceptable level of competence. I do not distinguish between excused and unexcused absences. Three (3) tardies constitute one (1) absence. Leaving early before class is concluded is also unacceptable and will be recorded. A student may be withdrawn from a class if the student has missed more than 25% of the class periods. This class meets once a week, which means that there are 5 meetings. If you miss one class it counts as 20% (you may not miss more than 1 class session). Exceeding the allowed absences in any amount beyond 25% will result in lowering the student's final course grade by one letter grade per absence exceeded

GRADING SCALE:

This course is presented in five weeks. Course grades are obtained by completing weekly papers (10 %), Class Participation (20%), Notes from readings (10%), Research Projects (10%), Presentations (25), a Class Journal (5%), and a Take Home Final (15%). These grades will be averaged for your course grade.
