# PROFESSOR POLICIES

#### **HOMEWORK:**

The student's name should appear in the upper right hand corner. Look the syllabus over carefully. You are not required to turn in homework on the actual day that we are scheduled to cover that material. All homework is listed on the day it is assigned and due at the <u>beginning of the next class meeting</u>. Application Assignments (Office 2003 book) will be printed. Concepts assignments (DC 2006) will be written out on a single page. Please note that class does not begin when you arrive; if you are late your homework is late. Homework assignments are considered given after that material is covered in class according to the tentative week-by-week schedule. Note: I give 50% credit for late work, which is <u>only</u> available until the test for that particular unit is administered. No homework is accepted after the last test.

#### TESTING:

It is mandatory that you are here for an exam on the date that the exam is administered. There are two types of tests in this course (SAM and your LAST TEST). SAM tests are only available for the <u>TIME SCHEDULED</u> (DATES GIVEN IN CLASS). Note: I do <u>not</u> use the testing center! There are no makeup tests.

#### **ATTENDANCE:**

My records for this class start with the official college semester (not student enrollment date). To receive attendance credit you must be here for the entire lecture. I do not distinguish between *excused* and *unexcused* absences. 3 tardies constitute 1 absence. Leaving early before the lecture is concluded is also unacceptable and will be recorded. I may use multiple attendance sheets to record your complete attendance. It is your responsibility to sign this sheet, when passed out, for a proper record of your presence (even if you are tardy). Note: Exceeding absences in any amount beyond 25% of the course (4 classes) will result in lowering the student's final course grade by one letter grade per absence exceeded.
