Are Pyramids in the Bible?

1 Kings 4:30 (wisdom of Egypt)

And Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the children of the east country, and all the wisdom of Egypt.

Acts 7:22 (*wisdom of the Egyptians*)

And Moses was learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and was mighty in words and in deeds.

Job 3:14 (desolate places?)

With kings and counsellers of the earth, which built desolate places for themselves;

Isaiah 14:18 (*king's house?*)

All the kings of the nations, even all of them, lie in glory, every one in his own house.

Isaiah 19:19-20 (altar? pillar? sign?)

19: In that day shall there be an <u>altar</u> to the LORD in the midst of the land of Egypt, and a <u>pillar</u> at the border thereof to the LORD.

20: And it shall be for a <u>sign</u> and for a witness unto the LORD of hosts in the land of Egypt: for they shall cry unto the LORD because of the oppressors, and he shall send them a saviour, and a great one, and he shall deliver them.

Jeremiah 43:12-13 (houses of the gods?)

12: And I will kindle a fire in the houses of the gods of Egypt; and he shall burn them, and carry them away captives: and he shall array himself with the land of Egypt, as a shepherd putteth on his garment; and he shall go forth from thence in peace.

13: He shall break also the images of Beth-shemesh, that is in the land of Egypt; and the houses of the gods of the Egyptians shall he burn with fire.

Zechariah 4:7 (headstone? Corner stone? Capstone?)

Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the <u>headstone</u> thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it.

Matthew 21:42 (headstone? Corner Stone? Capstone?)

Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the <u>head of the corner</u>: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?

Ephesians 2:19-22 (foundation? Headstone? Corner Stone? Capstone?)

19: Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God;

- 20: And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone;
- 21: In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord:
- 22: In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit.

Revelation 21:16 (*city foursquare?*)

And the city lieth <u>foursquare</u>, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.
