HEBREW BIBLE REFERENCES TO CONSIDER

Psalms 91:1,4 (Covering/Wings)

1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings** shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.

Numbers 15:37-41 (Fringes/Borders)

37 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

38 Speak unto the children of Israel, and bid them that they make them fringes* in the borders** of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put upon the fringe* of the borders** a ribband of blue†:

39 And it shall be unto you for a fringe,* that ye may look upon it, and remember all the commandments‡ of the LORD, and do them; and that ye seek not after your own heart^ and your own eyes, after which ye use to go a whoring:

40 That ye may remember, and do all my commandments,‡ and be holy unto your God.

41 I am the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I am the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 22:12 (Fringes/Corners)

Thou shalt make thee fringes° upon the four quarters** of thy vesture, wherewith thou coverest thyself.

Exodus 15:26 (Commandments/Healing)

And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments‡, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth§ thee.

Ruth 3:9 (Ruth/Boaz Garment)

And he said, Who art thou? And she answered, I am Ruth thine handmaid: spread therefore thy skirt** over thine handmaid; for thou art a near kinsman.

1 Samuel 15:27 (Saul tore Samuel's Garment)

And as Samuel turned about to go away, he laid hold upon the skirt** of his mantle, and it rent.

1 Samuel 24:4-5, 11 (David cut Saul's Garment)

4 And the men of David said unto him, Behold the day of which the LORD said unto thee, Behold, I will deliver thine enemy into thine hand, that thou mayest do to him as it shall seem good unto thee. Then David arose, and cut off the skirt** of Saul's robe privily.

5 And it came to pass afterward, that David's heart smote him, because he had cut off Saul's skirt.**

11 Moreover, my father, see, yea, see the skirt** of thy robe in my hand: for in that I cut off the skirt** of thy robe and killed thee not, know thou and see that there is neither evil nor transgression in mine hand, and I have not sinned against thee; yet thou huntest my soul to take it.

Malachi 4:2 (Messiah/Wings)

But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing§§ in his wings**; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

NEW TESTAMENT REFERENCES TO CONSIDER

Matthew 14:36 (Hem/Healing)

And besought him that they might only touch the **hem of his garment**: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole.

Mark 6:56 (Border/Healing)

And whithersoever he entered, into villages, or cities, or country, they laid the sick in the streets, and besought him that they might touch if it were but the **border of his garment**: and as many as touched him were made whole.

Luke 8:43-48 (Border/Healing)

43 And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any,
44 Came behind him, and touched the **border of his garment**: and immediately her issue of blood stanchèd.
45 And Jesus said, Who touched me? When all denied, Peter and they that were with him said, Master, the multitude throng thee and press thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me?
46 And Jesus said, Somebody hath touched me: for I perceive that virtue is gone out of me.
47 And when the woman saw that she was not hid, she came trembling, and falling down before him, she declared unto him before all the people for what cause she had touched him and how she was healed immediately.
48 And he said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.

Mark 5:27 (Garment/Healing)

When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his **garment**.

Matthew 9:21 (Garment/Healing)

For she said within herself, If I may but touch his **garment**, I shall be whole.

Matthew 6:6 (Prayer Closet/Private Sanctuary/Little Tent)

But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy **closet**, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in **secret**; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee **openly**.

John 11:44 (Napkin/Burial)

And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a **napkin**.
Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

John 20:7 (Napkin/Burial)

And the **napkin**, that was about his head, not lying with the linen clothes, but wrapped together in a place by itself.

Acts 18:3 (Sha'ul/Paul was a Tentmaker)

And because he was of the same craft, he abode with them, and wrought: for by their occupation they were **tentmakers**.

Matthew 23:5 (Messiah criticizing scribes and Pharisees)

But all their works they do for to be seen of men: they make broad their phylacteries, and enlarge the **borders of their garments**,

Acts 19:12 (Garments that brought healing)

So that from his body were brought unto the sick **handkerchiefs** or **aprons**, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.
